Children's Program

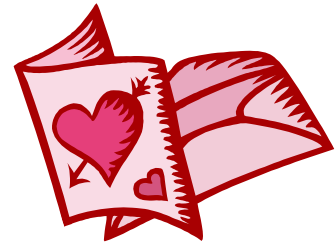

Income Tax Assistance!



Post cards were mailed out as a reminder to last year's clients for income tax assistance. We will not be accepting drop in's this year. If you are a current client of Stanford Settlement and have received assistance on your taxes within the last two years, here at Stanford, you may be eligible to make an appointment on the following Saturdays: February 25th - March 3rd. Please call Marisol at 927-1303.

Clients must bring:

- * Social Security card or Tax ID card for every person on the Tax Return
- * A current driver's license or ID card
- * Your current 2010 Tax Return
- * IRS forms, W-2 forms, 1098, 1099, property tax, retirement forms.

If you filing jointly with your spouse, both must be present. If you are a renter, bring the name and phone number of the person or management company you pay rent to.

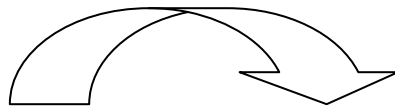
